Bwindi Impenetrable National Park is habitat to approximately half of the world's mountain gorillas. The National Park has 90 mammal species, plus 11 primates, of which the black-and-white colobus, with its beautiful flowing white tail, is famous.

1061 Bird species have been spotted in Uganda, and a Boat Cruise along the Kazinga Channel offers the opportunity of viewing hundreds of water birds - pelicans, flamingos; and huge mammals like hippos, buffaloes, elephant herds.

Chimpanzee Tracking in Uganda at Kibale Natinal Park

Tracking the chimpanzee is a very interesting experience. The way they feed, climb trees, respond to humans, caring for their young ones, is just phenomenal. Kibale Forest is Uganda's most gorgeous tropical forest. Its a habitat to many forest wildlife and among these include 13 species of primates along with chimpanzees. The southern part of Kibale connects to the heart of Queen Elizabeth National park. A Safari to Kibale offers opportunities for: Forest Hikes, Nature Trails and Cultural Tours to Community run Campsites close to the villages of Kikoni, Nyakalongo, and Nyabaida.
